A gemstone of extraordinary beauty and versatility, holds a rich history and a captivating array of colours. Named after the Latin word "granatus," meaning "seedlike". Garnets have been cherished for millennia for their deep hues and enduring allure.

Grossular garnet is comprised of two wellknown varieties, namely hessonite and tsavorite. They have been used in jewellery for centuries, particularly in ancient civilizations such as Egypt and Rome. In India. hessonite enjoys a special

position amongst "navratnas" and is very much popular as "gomed".

Tsavorite garnet is named after Tsavo National Park in Kenya, where it was first discovered in 1967 by British geologist Campbell Bridges. The gemstone's striking green colour is reminiscent of the lush vegetation found in the park.

Andradite garnets, exhibiting shades of green, yellow, and brown, are valued for their rarity and unique colour palette. The prized variety of andradite garnet is demantoid, which gained popularity during the late 19th and early 20th

centuries, particularly during the Art Nouveau period. The name "demantoid" is

derived from the Dutch word "demant," meaning diamond, owing to its diamond-like sparkle. Russia's Ural Mountains are the fabled source of this prized garnet.

Spessartine garnet is known for bright orange colour. The name is derived from 'Spessart', a region in Germany where these garnets were first discovered. The alternative name "spessartite" is also commonly used, referring to the same gemstone.

While garnets are found in locations worldwide, notable deposits include Africa, India, Sri Lanka, Brazil, and the United

States. The renowned Bohemian garnets from the Czech Republic have long been celebrated for their rich red colour and exceptional quality. Garnets with hardness between 6.5 to 7.5 on the Mohs scale qualify as a durable gemstone and is

suitable for a variety of jewellery. Their vibrant colours and excellent clarity make them a popular choice for both traditional and contemporary designs.

In addition to their aesthetic appeal, garnets hold symbolic significance as the birth stone for January, symbolizing friendship, trust, and loyalty. They are also traditionally given to commemorate second wedding anniversaries. representing enduring love and commitment.

From ancient civilizations to modern-day adornments, garnets continue to enchant with their timeless elegance and vivid hues, making them a cherished gemstone beloved by many.





UNSTABLE COLOUR OF YELLOW SAPPHIRES

Since past many years, one concern our laboratory has heard from clients is the issue of colour stability of yellow sapphires. Some sapphires, particularly those with stronger yellow component fade over a period after routine usage. It has been known for many years that yellow to orange yellow hues induced by colour centres (formed naturally or by artificial irradiation) in corundum are not always stable, thus resulting in a yellow colour that fades slowly upon exposure to daylight and/or heat. Most of these sapphires, however, are not subjected to hightemperature heating.

THE SEVEN TYPES OF **COLOURATION**

There are seven types of yellow sapphire colouration, as described by K. Nassau in 1987, which are listed below.

Type 1: Yellow colour derived from a yellow stable colour centre; colour may be lost by heating; restored by irradiation (natural or artificial); usually from Sri Lanka.

Type 2: Yellow developed by irradiation (natural or artificial) of colourless material; yellow fading colour centre; may have been found yellow but fades on exposure to light.

Type 3: Yellow colour derived from iron, not heated.

Type 4: Yellow type 3 colour, derived from iron, intensified by heating; may have been colourless when found.

Type 5: Colourless or pale material with surface diffused yellow added, using Ni or other element.

Type 6: Synthetic sapphire with Ni or other element present as yellow colourant.

Type 7: Synthetic colourless sapphire irradiated to produce yellow.

Considering the above seven types of vellow sapphire colouration, the first two types (type 1 and type 2) are of major concern. In the first type, if the colour is lost on exposure to light, it may be restored by irradiation or exposure to UV radiation (Figure 1). Exposure of these sapphires to strong light source would cause these stones to fade faster, typically in few hours. The colour, however, could easily be regained by exposure to ultraviolet light, in an artificial lamp or direct sunlight. This effect of fading in white light and reactivation by UV radiation is known in the scientific literature as reversible photochromism or tenebrescence. In type 2 sapphires, the mined stones are natural in colour but on exposure to light, may fade. Some deeper yellow sapphires fade to pale

yellow, while some fade to near colourless.

This depends on the components of unstable and stable colour centres present within the same stone. Sapphires having a combination of unstable and stable colour centres show noticeable reduction in vellow colour after fading, while those with only unstable colour centres fade to near colourless (Figure 2). As mentioned above, fading of colour is mainly a concern for yellow sapphires originating from metamorphic deposits, such as Sri Lanka or Madagascar, while those originating from basaltic deposits, such as Australia, Thailand or Tanzania are coloured by Fe3+, and are usually stable.

THE PROBLEM

Although, fading of yellow sapphires is a natural phenomenon, it raises concern over the authenticity of the sapphire under question. The sapphire which has not undergone any treatment still fades! And, till date, there is no gemmological test, which can determine if the suspected sapphire has unstable or stable colour centre.

THE 'FADE' OR 'COLOUR STABILITY' **TEST**

This test is a destructive method to estimate if the yellow sapphire has stable or unstable colour centre. When done, the test will bleach body colour of the sapphire, completely or partially. This test simply uses a strong light source, e.g. 150W halogen lamp. The suspected stone is kept directly beneath

the lamp in a metal plate at around 4 -6 inches away. The colour will start to bleach in exposure of few minutes; more the exposure time more will be the loss of colour. The duration of exposure to light source is highly variable and depends on the individual performing the test, but this may vary from 30 minutes to 3 hours.

CONCLUSION

Considering destructive method resulting in loss of colour, IIGJ -Research & Laboratories Centre currently is not performing fade or colour stability test. However, owner of the suspected sapphires may perform this test to determine their colour stability. It may please be noted that this test does not indicate if the sapphire has undergone heating or beryllium treatment.

Auction Results

COMMERCIAL QUALITY EMERALDS

Gemfields announced the results of an auction held during 5th-22nd March 2024 which comprised of commercial quality rough.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE AUCTION

- Total auction revenues of USD 17.1 million
- 43 lots were offered for sale, of which 40 were sold (93%)
- Average price of USD 4.45 per carat
- The 47 auctions of Kagem gemstones held since July 2009 have generated USD 1,006 million in total revenues, reaching the USD 1 billion mark



The specific auction mix and the quality of the lots offered at each auction vary in characteristics such as size, colour and clarity on account of variations in mined production and market demand. Therefore, the results of each auction are not always directly comparable.

The auction lots were made available for private, in-person viewings by customers in Jaipur. Following the viewings, the auctions took place via an online auction platform specifically adapted for Gemfields and which permitted customers from multiple jurisdictions to participate

in a sealedbid process. The rough emeralds sold were extracted by Kagem (which is 75% owned by Gemfields and 25% by the **Industrial Development** Corporation of Zambia). The proceeds of this auction will be fully repatriated to Kagem in Zambia with all royalties due to the Government of

the Republic of Zambia being paid on the full sales prices achieved at the auction.


